





## **Solvy Water Soluble**

## How Clear and Defined is your Embroidery on Towels and Raised fabrics?

**Water soluble** topping such as **Solvy** can sometimes be referred to as a second skin. Once a sandwich of Solvy, fabric and backing is hooped and the embroidery is stitched, it **prevents** the stitches from **sinking** into the garment and losing the design or lettering's definition. It is clear and precise compared to if the embroidery was stitched directly onto a garment with high pile or texture such as **toweling**, **cordorouy knit**, **wool**, **fleece** etc...

Solvy is **ideal** to use when embroidering **small lettering on knit** shirts to help them stand out and sit on top of the garment making it crisp and clear. Fleece is also a popular embroidered garments for winter months.

## Here's How to Use It.

Step1. Hoop the item you are embroidering up with Backing underneath(as normal), Fabric in the middle ,and **SOLVY** on top(to keep pile down).

Step.2 Embroider your Design.

Step 3. Remove excess solvy and Backing once the design is finished.

Step.4 If you still see remnants of the excess SOLVY try using a Spray bottle, Damp Cloth, or a Garment Steamer!

REMEMBER! Always keep your SOLVY in a plastic bag!
